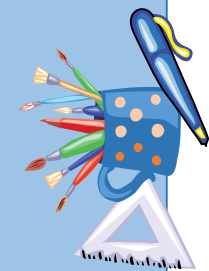
### How to Order:

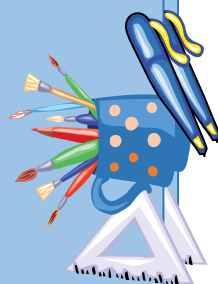

Together we can do it! Together we did!





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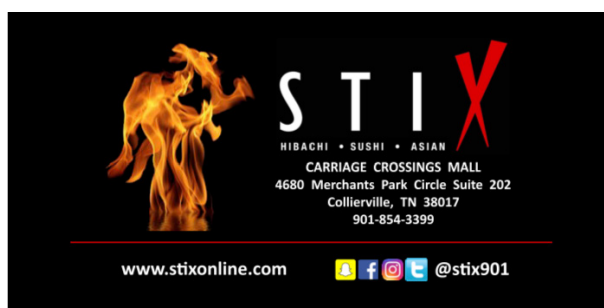
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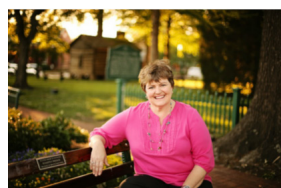

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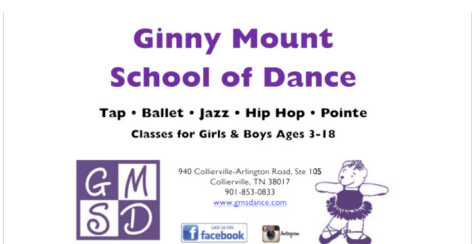
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
